Applications on plain paper are invited within 30 days from the date of publishing of this advertisement from eligible candidates for one post of Assistant Professor (History of Art) in National Museum Institute, New Delhi in the pay band of Rs. 15600-39100 + AGP Rs. 6000/- p.m. + allowances. The selected candidate will be on probation for 2 years. The candidate should possess :

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS :

- (a) Good academic record with at least 55% marks or an equivalent grade of "B" in the 7 point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E & F at the Master's degree level in History of Art/History/ Anthropology/ Archaeology from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from a foreign University
- (b) Should have cleared the eligibility test (NET/SLET) for Lecturers conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC. Provided, however, that candidates, who are or have been awarded Ph.D. degree in compliance of the UGC (Minimum standards and procedure for award of Ph.D. degree), Regulation 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET.

DESIRABLE :

- (i) Ph.D. degree holders may be given weightage by the competent authority.
- (ii) Knowledge of either Russian, German, French, Spanish, Italian and one regional Indian Language

AGE : Not to exceed 40 years on the closing date for receipt of applications.

GENERAL : In-service candidates should apply through proper channel. The candidates are required to give full details of their name, date of birth, qualifications, whether belonging to SC/ST/OBC, past experience, particulars of posts held previously, etc. A passport size recent photograph duly signed should also be pasted on the top right side of the application. Attested photocopies in proof of educational qualifications/experience should be enclosed with the application. Incomplete applications or applications received late will not be entertained.
